

Agility is a growing dog sport in the United States, with over 1 million entries to the AKC's program each year. Agility is a dog sport in which a handler directs a dog through an obstacle course in a race for both time and accuracy. Dogs run off-leash with the handler's controls limited to voice, movement, and various body signals, requiring exceptional training of the animal and coordination of the handler.

In its simplest form, an agility course consists of a set of standard obstacles laid out by a judge in a design of his or her own choosing in an area of a specified size. The surface may be of grass, dirt, rubber, or special matting. Depending on the type of competition, the obstacles may be marked with numbers indicating the order in which they must be completed.

Whether you just want to have fun exercising with your dog or want to go further and enter an Agility competition, get ready for a fastpaced, rewarding experience that will get you and your dog in the best shape of your lives!

Rally is more than just dog training. Rally training involves a course made up of signs, with each sign representing turns or commands such as stay, sit, and down that need to be completed by the dog and their handler.

Teaching your dog tricks is a great way to provide mental stimulation, increase flexibility and boost their confidence while having a great time. Tricks are simply behaviors, and learning these behaviors puts the dog in a learning-to-learn mode. Tricks are behaviors that can be done for entertainment such as "paw and roll over," physical activity (such as weave poles or spin), or as useful practical skills (e.g., "back up" or "retrieve an item").

Trick training will make a trainer out of any owner that loves their dog. Correctly using the behavioral principles of shaping, chaining and reinforcement will be key of the successful trick dog trainer. We love the fact that trick dog training requires the handler and dog to work together as a team.
